The Shots have performed at various outings and functions throughout the North Jersey area.

Please plan to arrive early and enjoy the concert beginning at 6:45 pm featuring The Shots. The fireworks are scheduled to begin at 8:30 pm.

This year will be the 53rd year the Wyckoff Volunteer Fire Department has provided the fireworks display as the Volunteer Fire Department's annual fundraiser. It has become an annual tradition in Wyckoff. **A Few Safety Reminders for Those Planning to Attend the Wyckoff Volunteer Fire
Department Fireworks Fundraiser**

Wyckoff Police Chief Benjamin C. Fox reminds us that to improve public safety, increased security measures will be employed at the Annual Wyckoff Volunteer Fire Department fireworks fundraiser. Chief Fox suggests arriving early to avoid delays at entry points. Attendees are also discouraged from bringing coolers, knapsacks, etc. to Memorial Field as this will delay entry. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited and will not be permitted in the Municipal Complex. All seating for the fireworks fundraiser will be on the rear baseball field near the Bandshell.

Handicapped parking will be available at the Wyckoff Public Library. Vehicles must display a valid handicapped parking permit and may enter Woodland Avenue via Monroe Avenue only. All vehicle access will be denied beginning at 7:30 pm when only pedestrian traffic will be permitted within the Municipal Complex.

Police and Fire personnel will be available at the entrances to direct and assist spectators.
