**NOTICE TO RESIDENTS TO REMOVE BRANCHES
FROM EDGE OF ROAD TO BEGIN**

The Special Emergency Collection of branches that fell from the October 29, 2011 snow storm was completed on December 7, 2011. The town-wide program was announced on November 2, 2011 requesting residents to place branches at the edge of their lawn by November 4, 2011. The branch collection began in District 1 on November 7, 2011. The collection was performed on all roads in the Township as announced following the sequence of leaf collection/voting districts and completed on December 7, 2011.

The leaf crews collected a total of 17,444 cubic yards of brush and branches or 436 dumpster loads from 92 miles of Township roads. Many thanks to the residents who cut their branches into 4 foot lengths; this assisted the collection crew since it enabled them to work quicker and enter the next district sooner.

On December 9, 2011 a notice was posted that the Township has completed the branch collection and residents can bring any further branches to the Recycling Center, cut branches into 4 foot lengths and place in containers or contract with a private landscape company or tree company for branch removal. The Police Department has begun notifying residents who placed additional branches at the curb which advises them to remove their branches from the curb or expect further enforcement.
