### **TOWNSHIP 2011 CALENDAR TO CELEBRATE Wyckoff's Unofficial Status as The Garden Town in the Garden State**

To celebrate Wyckoff's unofficial status as "The Garden Town in the Garden State", the team behind the Township's award-winning municipal calendar is seeking the participation of residents in creating the 2011 calendar. Specifically, they are asking residents of all ages to contribute photos that show what their gardens look like – from flowers in bloom to ripening vegetables to the many "heritage" trees that adorn our community. The goal is to appreciate the natural beauty that characterizes Wyckoff, but which is sometimes taken for granted.

Photos can depict private gardens or the many public "green" areas around the Township. That includes photos of residents' perennials in full spring bloom to photos of Zabriskie Pond Park or the Gardens at Wyckoff in their autumn glory. The calendar team is hoping to present a complete picture of how the Township's gardens grow.

Residents can submit photos for the calendar in several ways.
