“RECYCLE YOUR OLD REFRIGERATOR/FREEZER & RECEIVE \$30”

The New Jersey State Board of Public Utilities has launched a new “clunker” refrigerator / freezer recycling program. Under the new program, New Jerseyans can have their old and inefficient appliances removed from inside their home for free and receive a payment of \$30 from the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities. These old appliances use two to four times the electricity of newer models. Replacing an older refrigerator/freezer can save \$50 a year in electricity costs. Residents can save on their electricity bills while helping to protect the environment.

Here’s how to participate:

- To schedule a pick-up of a refrigerator or freezer, New Jersey residents must first call 877-270-3520 or visit NJCleanEnergy.com
- The program is limited to the removal of two units per household.
- Appliances must be in working order with an inside measurement of 10 – 30 cubic feet.
- Residents will receive a check for \$30 within 90 – 120 days after collection of the appliance.
