1) Priority Review Items:

- a) Sustainable Jersey Actions for 2023 Submission- Chairwoman Fischer stated that there are currently four expired actions for a total of 45-50 points for the 2023 Re-Certification that can realistically be submitted. The next cycle due date is May 12. Ms. Fischer has requested this item to be tabled at the next meeting in April.
- b) 2023 WEC Events
 - i) Team Up to Tidy Up (TUTU) will be held on Saturday, April 22, the same day as Earth Day, with a rain date of April 29. Volunteers are needed. Thank you to Commissioner Ammerman's husband for reworking the new WEC logo which will be used for the T-shirt. Volunteers to meet at 8:00am. The set up will be the day before, Friday, April 21. Volunteers needed to help with Friday setup.
 - ii) Composting Event- scheduled for Saturday, April 1, 10:00am at Russell Farms. Composters will be sold during the spring and tentative fall events for 2023. Chair will do the Backyard Composting 101 presentation followed by a Q&A. Commission Weiner will address answer questions in his capacity as a certified Master Gardener. Flyer was updated and posted on Township website and social media. Chairwoman Fischer will send flyers to PTO and schools.
 - *iii*) Shred/Recycling Day- scheduled for Saturday, April 15. Volunteers will meet at DPW at 8:15am. Mrs. Fischer will coordinate the Green Team and WEC volunteers.
 - iv) YMCA Healthy Kids Day April 22- WEC and Green Team volunteers will participate after Team Up to Tidy Up Day.
 - v) Fishing Derby- scheduled for Saturday, June 3 at 8:30am. Commissioners will review suggestions from the 2022 event and report back at the April meeting.
- 2) **Grant Programs** A Sustainable Jersey/PSE&G small grant of \$2,000 was submitted on February 10, 2023, for signage upgrade at the Russell Farms Community Park. Award announcements will be made in April. Mrs. Fischer would like to submit an ANJEC Open Space Stewardship Project grant of \$1,500 for the Eisenhower Middle school community vegetable garden. The due date for the grant is April 17. Mr. Weiner will work on a draft and Mrs. Fischer will submit a proposal to the Town Hall for approval.
- 3) Planning Board Commissioner Bogdansky reported a new project involving Hackensack Meridian Urgent care application to open a facility in the Boulder Run shopping Center near the side of Stop and Shop along Godwin Avenue. Ridgewood Water will be holding a special meeting for the development of a second water treatment facility near the Cedar Hill area. Per inquiry from WEC, Maple Lake development has yet not begun.
