#### 1) Priority Review Items:

- Team Up to Tidy Up (TUTU) was held on Saturday, April 22, Approximately 100 fewer volunteers this
  year, possibly due to baseball/softball season opening day. Approximately 25 public sites areas were
  cleaned of litter. A suggestion was made to possibly move the event to May instead of April to be discussed when planning for 2024.
- Fishing Derby- Saturday, June 3, 2023 8:00am to 10:30am for volunteer sign-ups. Commissioner Fischer will coordinate volunteers for the Fishing Derby. Mr. Melchionne stated Peter's Fish Market would like to donate prizes. He will contact them for more details. An information table with educational information on clean water and stormwater management will be set up next to the registration tables.
- Healthy Kids Day Chairwoman Fischer and Junior Commissioners Gabrielle B. and Eve N. staffed two
   (2) information tables on composting and pollinators. Commissioner Koeber put together seed packets as giveaways.
- Air Quality Awareness Week, May 1 5 WEC sent a No Idling to the K-8 Wyckoff Schools for the principal e-blasts. The schools also celebrated National Walk, Bike, & Roll to School Week.

#### 2) **Grant Programs:**

- Sustainable Jersey/PSE&G \$2,000.00 Small Grant written by Chairwoman Fischer was awarded. Project
  is for improvement to Russell Farms Community Park signage. Ms. Capparelli will accept the check on
  behalf of the WEC at the May 22 Awards Ceremony and post a public announcement about the award.
  Ms. Fischer, Mr. Melchionne, and the DPW rep will plan a meeting at Russell Farms Park to assess the
  current signs and discuss improvements. Potential topics for signs include information on native pollinators, plant ID and description of the Sensory Garden, a revised diagram of the tree farm.
- The application for the ANJEC Open Space Stewardship Grant for the Wyckoff Community Garden at Eisenhower Middle School was not approved.

- Sustainable Jersey Bergen HUB Ben Weiner reported on Ridgewood's Densifying Unit. Ridgewood is
  discussing opening the unit to other towns to use, further research is required. Plastic Bag Ban report
  from Governor Murphy: after 1 year, approximately 5.5 million bags were not given out. Plastic Straws –
  stores have gone from 17 million plastic straws given out to 2 million.
- Recycle Coach 37 new subscribers for April 2023, YTD since 2018 = 3,717
