- 4. Re-Organization of Shade Tree Commission.
 - a. Glenn Sietsma made a motion to nominate Mark Borst, Chair of the Shade Tree Commission. Seconded by Scott Fisher. All present voted in favor. Motion carried.

- Approval of the meeting minutes from December 2, 2014. Scott Fisher made motion to approve December meeting minutes as written, seconded by Glenn Sietsma. All present voted in favor; motion approved.
- 6. New Business
 - a. Arbor Day Celebration April 25, 2015.
 - Chair Borst stated a location should be decided upon for Arbor Day. A wide range of areas were discussed for the Arbor Day Celebration. A consensus appeared to exist to complete the reforesting of the Zabriskie Pond Park with additional willow trees to be planted on the Franklin Avenue side of the Park.
