- Your Fire Department is staffed by resident volunteers who train every Monday night to develop and fine-tune skills such as search & rescue techniques, fire suppression, fire ground communication and rescue of persons trapped in vehicles.
- The Wyckoff tradition of neighbors volunteering as firefighters is in its 110th year.
- Last year in 2016, your volunteer firefighters; responded to 612 calls for service; devoted 6,874 man-hours responding to emergency alarms of fire and attended 15,854 hours of training sessions.
