- Optional demonstration of Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Ideal for the lay person who wants to be able to help in the case of an emergency. NO CERTIFICATION is offered for this course
- Course time: approx 2.5 hours
- Suggested donation: \$15*
- Course can be broken into two shorter sessions for interested groups

Courses available include:

Heartsaver AED

- Certification course appropriate for any lay rescuer
- Learn CPR and relief of choking in adults and children
- Become certified in the use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Optional certification in infant CPR and choking
- Excellent for all lay rescuers, but especially for those requiring a card documenting completion of a CPR course
- Certification good for 2 years
- Course time: approx 3 hours
- Suggested donation: \$30*

BLS for the Healthcare Provider

- Certification course designed for people in health care and emergency services, including doctors, nurses, EMTs, lifeguards and many more.
- Learn CPR and choking relief in adults, children and infants.
- Become certified in use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Certification good for 2 years
- Course time: approx 4 hours
- Suggested donation \$50*

Heartsaver First Aid classes are also available upon request, and any class can be specially arranged for groups. All courses feature a practice-while-watching DVD format and an AHA manual available prior to course date.
