Recreation Director's Report:

Travel Baseball Question/Discussions

New Program for Winter – Discussion and Recommendation

Over the Summer, for the first time, the town ran a "Fairy Camp" for a small number of younger girls in conjunction with our Summer Day Camp. The participants had a great experience and overall feedback was positive. Since this camp provides alternative recreational activities outside of the traditionally offered sports, and it is not constrained to a particular season, the board supported offering the camp for the upcoming Winter. Andy will work with the Township on adding this program to our list of programs.

New Fundraising Idea for Recreation – Discussion and Recommendation

Andy discussed selling iPhone covers developed by a Township resident with his company that display the various Wyckoff sports teams and can be individualized with names, positions, and uniform numbers. In addition to showing support for our teams, profits from the sales would go back to the Recreation Department. The proposal was unanimously supported and approved.

On-Line Registration Coming to Wyckoff – Setup In Process

Andy discussed how he and Beverly had been spending a lot of time helping to set up the online registration site. It is expected to be functional in September. This will be a huge convenience for all of the families in town and is highly anticipated. Residents will no longer have to register in person and will be able to pay for programs with their credit cards on their computers at home.
