**SUMMER BASEBALL CAMP**

CAMP DATES: UP TO 4 WEEKS IN JULY/AUGUST

**A. THE SUPPLIERS OF A SUMMER BASEBALL CAMP SHALL PROVIDE:**

1. The Baseball Camp specified within shall be provided on Memorial Field when possible and Wyckoff Community Park if Memorial Field is unavailable during a period in July/August determined by the Wyckoff Recreation Director and the bidder's Director of Camp based on field and site availability. The Wyckoff Recreation Director's decision shall be final. Dates for the second year contract and the two additional one- year contracts, if authorized, must be conducted during the exact comparable calendar week as determined in the first- year contract.
2. Individualized instruction with ability grouping by age.
3. Camp for Boys entering Grade 1 through 8, to be separated by age accordingly.
4. One Camp shirt to each participant (to be kept by each participant at the conclusion of the camp).
5. Twenty-five (25) to thirty (30) hours of instruction per week.
6. In the event of rain that precludes the camp program from being held, make-up days shall be on the Saturday of the specific week. The Recreation Director shall make the determination if a camp day shall be canceled due to weather conditions.
7. The ratio of on-field instructors to registrants shall be no greater than one (1) instructor to ten (10) registrants.
8. All bidders shall fully complete and submit with their bid the attached camp experience and reference questionnaire.
9. The Director and all instructors of the camp must presently be a college or high school Baseball coach or have at least 5 years of head coaching at the high school or college level.
10. The Director and instructors of the camp must be NJ Certified teachers.
11. All field assistants must be a minimum of 16 years of age.
12. An athletic trainer must be on site during all hours of operation. **Proof of registration with the State of New Jersey as a certified athletic trainer must be provided to the Wyckoff Recreation Director no later than 30 calendar days before the start of the first day of camp.**
13. **Property damage:** The Contractor shall be held responsible for all damages or injury done by those in his employ to Township facilities. The Contractor shall restore or repair, at his own expense, in a manner satisfactory to the owner, such property as was damaged by those in his employ during the execution of the project. In case of failure on the part of the Contractor to restore or repair such property in the manner satisfactory to the owner, the Township Administrator may, upon 48-hours notice to the Contractor, proceed to make such repairs or restore such property, that in his judgment has been injured or damaged by the Contractor or those in his employ, and the cost thereof will be paid by the Contractor.
14. **Insurance Requirements:** The Contractor shall be required to carry full insurance including comprehensive general liability; product liability; worker's compensation insurance; which shall cover all operations of the Contractor, its employees, agents and servants hereunder, and; motor vehicles and used by the Contractor in connection with the Contractor's operations under the Contract. Said insurance, by endorsement, shall fully protect the Township from liability.

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 25 day of JANUARY, 2021, BETWEEN:

THE TOWNSHIP OF WYCKOFF, a municipal corporation in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey,

This Agreement is hereinafter referred to as the "Contract".

The OWNER and CONTRACTOR intending to be legally bound and in consideration of the promises contained herein agree as follows:

1. The CONTRACTOR shall provide a Summer Baseball instructional camp for the specific weeks listed in the specification. The CONTRACTOR shall provide this Summer Baseball instructional camp and perform the requirements of the specification which is annexed hereto and made a part thereof.
2. The CONTRACTOR shall pay to the OWNER on the first day of camp, the amount of:  
\$ .25 per registered camper.
3. The following items, when attached hereto, shall be deemed part of the Contract between the parties and hereby incorporated herein by reference:
  - a. Legal Notice
  - b. Instructions and Requirements
  - c. Proposal Form
  - d. This Agreement
  - e. Complete Specifications
  - f. Acknowledgement of Receipt of Changes to Bid Documents (if applicable)
  - g. Notice of Award
4. The OWNER shall allow the CONTRACTOR to utilize the public facilities

as detailed in the specifications.

5. The CONTRACTOR shall diligently perform its obligation hereunder at such times and in such order as the Township Administrator or his designee shall direct. The CONTRACTOR shall perform the work under this Agreement by the use of its own organization, i.e., Directors, Associate Directors, Field Instructors, Field Assistants and Athletic Trainer, but using its own equipment, all without subcontracting. If the service required under this Contract is not completed promptly and without delay, the CONTRACTOR shall be deemed to be in default under this Contract and shall pay the OWNER as liquidated damages and not as a penalty, the amount of \$250.00 for each and every calendar day the completion of the work is delayed beyond the date the CONTRACTOR is determined by the Township Administrator to be in default under the terms of this Contract. In addition thereto, the OWNER shall have the right to terminate this Contract for such default by CONTRACTOR by notifying the CONTRACTOR in writing of such termination, but nevertheless, the CONTRACTOR shall remain liable for monetary damages which OWNER may incur.
6. It is further understood and agreed that the CONTRACTOR shall have no claim for any bonus or other additional compensation in the event of completion of the work before the time and date agreed upon.
7. The CONTRACTOR shall comply with all requirements of the bid specification including the requirement for providing staff to perform the Summer Baseball Camp who have received a criminal background check satisfactory to the requirements of the specifications. The OWNER SHALL submit the report from the third-party independent company which performed the criminal background checks to the Wyckoff Recreation Director thirty (30) calendar days before the start of the Summer Baseball camp.
8. In the event of a dispute between CONTRACTOR and OWNER as to whether or not CONTRACTOR has performed the service in compliance with the Contract, the Township Recreation Director, with the advice of the Township Administrator or such other person having the appropriate profession or technical expertise pertinent to this Contract, shall make a determination as to whether or not the CONTRACTOR has complied with this Contract and it is hereby agreed that such determination shall be conclusive on the issue of such compliance and the parties shall be bound accordingly.


5. The Contractor agrees to provide a Certificate of Insurance designating the Township of Wyckoff as an additional insured, providing general liability, bodily injury and property damage coverage with minimum limits of liability not less than \$500,000.
