**WHEREAS**, an emergency has arisen with respect to expenses incurred due to the Bergen County Prosecutors office monitoring of the Wyckoff Police Department, for legal other expense, and no adequate provision has been made in the budget for the aforesaid purpose; and,

**WHEREAS**, on November 8, 2011, the voters of the Township of Wyckoff approved a public question on the general election ballot to extend the Municipal Open Space Trust Fund for five (5) additional years, January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2016; and,

**WHEREAS**, the use of Municipal Open Space Trust Fund monies for historic preservation activities and improvements is authorized through the adoption of Wyckoff Ordinance No. 1656 and approved by voters on Tuesday, November 8, 2011.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Wyckoff, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey that authorization is granted to utilize \$132,000 of Municipal Open Space Trust Fund tax monies to renovate, rehabilitate and restore the Zabriskie House historical site located at 421 Franklin Avenue, Wyckoff, New Jersey.
